

COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No 236/D/236

In the Matter of Land adjacent to Upper House Farm, Shamley Green, Wonersh, Surrey (No. 1)

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Enty No. 1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No. CL 83 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Surrey County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 341 made by the former Surrey County Council and noted in the Register on 12 October 1970.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Guildford on 3 May 1979. The hearing was attended by Mr C Wells, Solicitor, on behalf of the Executors of the Late Lord Tangley, whose application for the registration was noted under Section 4(4) of the Commons Registration Act 1965, Miss A M Deacon, Solicitor, on behalf of the Waverley District Council, and Mr D Angus, Solicitor, on behalf of the Surrey County Council.

Mr Angus informed me that he was instructed not to pursue the Objection.

In these circumstances I confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Common Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
