

In the Matter of Land adjacent to Upper House

Farm, Shamley Green, Wonersh, Surrey (No. 2)

## DECISION

This dispute relates to the registrations at Entry Nos. 1 and 2 in the Rights section of Register Unit No. CL 83 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Surrey County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 341 made by the former Surrey County Council and noted in the Register on 12 October 1970.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Guildford on 3 May 1979. The hearing was attended by Mr D Angus, Solicitor, on behalf of the Surrey County Council. There was no appearance by or on behalf of the applicants for either of the registrations, but Mr Angus informed me that he was instructed not to pursue the Objection.

In these circumstances I confirm both registrations.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
