



In the Matter of Land adjoining Blackhams,
Mill Lane, Chiddingfold, Surrey.

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land section of Register Unit No. CL 450 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Surrey County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 730 made by the former Surrey County Council and noted in the Register on 2 August 1972.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Guildford on 21 May 1981. The hearing was attended by Mr B Cotter, solicitor, on behalf of the Surrey County Council and by Miss A M Deacon, solicitor, on behalf of the Waverley District Council. There was no appearance by or on behalf of Col. D K Price, the applicant for the registration, but his solicitors stated in a letter dated 6 May 1981, addressed to the Clerk of the Commons Commissioners, that he was not proposing to adduce any evidence at the hearing.

In these circumstances I refuse to confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
