



In the Matter of Land at Gosden Common,
Bramley, Surrey (No. 1)

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land section of Register Unit No. CL 148 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Surrey County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 353 made by the former Surrey County Council and noted in the Register on 14 October 1970.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Guildford on 20 March 1980. The hearing was attended by Mr R Hart, Solicitor, on behalf of the Waverley District Council, the successor authority of the former Hambledon Rural District Council, the applicant for the registration, and Mr B E H Cotter, Solicitor, on behalf of the Surrey County Council. There was no appearance by or on behalf of the personal representatives of the late Mr F D Fenston, the applicant for the registration of rights of common over the land comprised in the Register Unit.

Mr Hart informed me that he was instructed not to support the registration.

In these circumstances I refuse to confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
