

COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No. 236/D/439

In the Matter of Land at junction of Tandridge Lane and Southlands Lane known as the Cage, Tandridge D

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No. CL 503 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Surrey County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 570 made by Surrey County Council and noted in the Register on 26 May 1972.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Oxted on 24 June 1981. The hearing was attended by Mr B E H Cotter, Solicitor, of Surrey County Council: by Mr K I Davison, the applicant for registration and by Mr P G Forsyth, Clerk to Tandridge Parish Council, also an applicant for registration.

Mr Davison and Mr Forsyth both accepted the Objection and accordingly I refuse to confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
