



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No. 236/D/226

In the Matter of Land at Wood Street,
Worplesdon, Surrey (No. 1)

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No 1 in the Land section of Register Unit No.CL.73 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Surrey County Council and is occasioned by the conflicting registration at Entry No 1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No.VG.39 in the Register of Town or Village Greens maintained by the Council.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Guildford on 4 May 1979. The hearing was attended by Mr W F Norris, Solicitor, on behalf of Mrs I E Ball, in consequence of whose application for the registration at Entry No 1 in the Rights Section of the Register Unit this registration was made, and by Mr P F Myers, solicitor, on behalf of the Surrey County Council. It having been agreed between the parties that the registration at Entry No 1 in the Rights Section should be confirmed with a modification, it only remains for me to confirm this registration.

I am required by regulation 30 (1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
