



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference Nos. 236/D/263-264

In the Matter of Little Bookham Common and
Wastes, Near Leatherhead, Mole Valley D

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry Nos. 1 and 2 in the Rights Section of Register Unit No. CL 259 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Surrey County Council and is occasioned by Objection Nos. 281 and 713 both made by The National Trust and noted in the Register on 7 October 1970 and 2 August 1972.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Guildford on 18 October 1979. The hearing was attended by Mr D J Carter on behalf of the National Trust, who had prior to the hearing agreed with Mr Webster the applicant under Entry No. 1 that I should confirm this Entry modified by deleting all the words in Column 4 and substituting therefore the words:

"The right to graze 4 horses on this Unit and Unit No. CL 96 provided that no more than 4 horses shall be grazed at any one time over either or both of such Units AND a right of estovers".

Mr Hinde the applicant under Entry No. 2 did not appear to support his application and I refuse to confirm Entry No. 2.

For the reason stated above I confirm the registration at Entry No. 1 modified as aforesaid.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
