DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No 1 in the Rights Section of Register Unit No CL. 266 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Surrey County Council and is occasioned by Objection No 6 made by the Urban District Council of Esher and noted in the Register on 3<sup>rd</sup> October 1968.

Mr Leslie James Curtis on whose application the said registration was made and Elmbridge Borough Council (the successors of the said Esher Council) being all the persons entitled to be heard at the hearing of this dispute have agreed upon the terms of the decision to be given by me and have sent to the Clerk of the Commons Commissioners particulars of such terms signed by or on behalf of all such persons, such terms being that the Commons Commissioner do refuse to confirm the said registration.

I am satisfied that there is no person who, if a hearing were held, would be entitled to be heard upon giving his name and address to me and satisfying me that he had succeeded to the interest, or part of the interest of any other person.

I am willing to give a decision in accordance with the proposed terms and I accordingly refuse to confirm the registration.
