

In the Matter of Lordshill Common and Municipal Waste, Wonersh, Waverley DC

## DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land section of Register Unit No. CL 172 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Surrey County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 358 made by Surrey County Council and noted in the Register on 14 October 1970.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Guildford on 3 February 1981. At the hearing the County Council was represented by Mr D C Rice, Solicitor, and Waverley District Council by Mr R A Hart, Solicitor.

The registration was made on the application of Hambledon RDC, to which Waverley District Council is successor. The Objection relates to strips of land claimed by the County Council to be highway and is not resisted by the District Council. Accordingly I confirm the registration, modified by excluding the strips, which are coloured red on the plan accompanying the Objection.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
