



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

In the Matter of Lucks Green,

DECISION

These disputes relate to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the 4th and Section of Register Unit No. CL 454 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Surrey County Council and are occasioned by three Objections: No. 97 by J F Dobbe and D R Gilham, No. 629 by Hambledon RDC and No. 645 by Surrey County Council, respectively noted in the Register on 4 June 1970 and 3 July 1972 and 1 August 1972.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the disputes at Guildford on 4 February 1981. The hearing was attended by Mr G V Hinde, the applicant for registration: by Mr B E H Cotter, Solicitor of and representing Surrey County Council: and by Mr R A Hart, Solicitor of and representing Waverley District Council (successor to Hambledon RDC).

Agreement had been reached between the parties, and I will give effect to the agreement by confirming the registration modified by excluding from the land the sections to which the three Objections relate.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
