



In the Matter of Manorial Waste, Alfold,
Waverley D

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No. CL 194 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Surrey County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 206 made by Surrey County Council and noted in the Register on 10 September 1970.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Guildford on 4 March 1981. The hearing was attended by B E H Cotter, Solicitor, of the County Council, and Mr A R Hart, Solicitor of Waverley District Council, the successor Authority to Hambledon R D C, the applicant for registration.

It had been agreed that the registration be cancelled and accordingly I refuse to confirm it.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
