



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No. 236/D/593-596

In the Matter of Manorial Waste Frensham Waverley D.

DECISION

These disputes relate to the registration at Entry No 1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No. CL.238 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Surrey County Council and are occasioned by four Objections: No. 162 by Surrey County Council, No. 175 by A R Billiard No. 191 by the Ministry of Defence No 450 by F C E Telfer and Mrs D C Wood, noted in the Register respectively on 1 September 1970, 4 September 1970 9 September 1970 and 29 September 1970.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the disputes at Guildford on 5 February 1981. The hearing was attended by Mr Billiard in person: Surrey County Council was represented by Mr B E H Cotter, Solicitor: Frensham Parish Council by Mr C Stagg its Chairman and Waverley District Council (successor to Hambledon RDC, the applicant for registration) by Mr R A Hunt Solicitor.

The Ministry of Defence had notified withdrawal of its Objection. All parties present were in agreement that the registration should be cancelled and accordingly I refuse to confirm it.

I am required by regulation 30 (1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
