



In the Matter of Manorial Waste,  
Hambleton, Surrey

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land section of Register Unit No. CL 166 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Surrey County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 153 made by the former Surrey County Council and noted in the Register on 1 September 1970.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Guildford on 19 March 1980. The hearing was attended by Mr R Hart, Solicitor, on behalf of the Waverley District Council, the successor authority of the former Hambleton Rural District Council, the applicant for the registration, and by Mr B E H Cotter, Solicitor, on behalf of the Surrey County Council.

Mr Hart and Mr Cotter informed me that it had been agreed that I should be asked to confirm the registration with the exclusion of all the land comprised in the Register Unit other than the land adjoining Vann Lane from Little Pockford northward to Vann Farm outside the ditch draining the highway on each side of the road. This I accordingly do.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
