

In the Matter of Manorial Waste, Tilford, Surrey.

DECISION

These disputes relate to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land section of Register Unit No. CL 242 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Surrey County Council and are occasioned by Objection No. 18 made by the Tilford Parish Council and noted in the Register on 21 January 1969. Objection No. 166 made by the former Surrey County Council and noted in the Register on 1 September 1970, and Objection No 173 made by Mr K H Whitaker and noted in the Register on 4 September 1970.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Guildford on 20 May 1981. The hearing was attended by Mr P Fisher, solicitor, on behalf of the Waverley District Council, the successor authority of the former Hambledon Rural District Council, the applicant for the registration, and by Mr B Cotter, solicitor, on behalf of the Surrey County Council. There was no appearance by or on behalf of the Parish Council or Mr Whitaker.

Mr Fisher informed me that he was instructed not to resist the Objection.

In these circumstances I refuse to confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
