In the Matter of Manorial Waste in the Farish of Thursley, Waverley D

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land section of Register Unit No. CL 226 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Surrey County Council and is occasioned by a number of Objections. These are No. 190 by the Ministry of Defence noted in the Register on 9 September 1970, No. 1 by C and M Peterson noted on 1 October 1970, No. 2 by Hester A O Prentice noted on 1 October 1970, No. 14 by Michael O'Brien noted on 14 November 1968 and No. 161 by Surrey County Council noted on 1 September 1970.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Guildford on 5 March 1981. The hearing was attended by Mr B E H Cotter, Solicitor, of Surrey County Council, by Mr A R Hart, Solicitor of Waverley District Council, successor Authority to Hambledon R D C, applicant for the registration, by Mr and Mrs Peterson (Objection No. 1) and by Mr R Thompson who claims to be successor to the part of the land to which Objection No. 2 relates.

The Objections, which relate to different parts of the land ("the Unit land"), were accepted by Waverley District Council to a large extent and the partial acceptance was agreed by Mr Cotter. The result is that I confirm the registration with the modification that there by excluded from the Unit land (1) the parts to which Objections No. 190, No. 1, No. 2 and No. 14 relate: (2) the parts coloured red on the plan accompanying Objections No. 161, but so that for this purpose (a) the area adjoining the three Horseshoes to be excluded shall be as shown on the attached plan and not as shown on the Objection plan, (b) the area to be excluded at the junction of D 136, D 137 and D 138 shall be limited to the carriageway and verges not exceeding 1 metre in width on either side.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
