

COMMONS RECISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No. 236/D/615-617

In the Matter of Part of Loxhill and Gorebridge Green, Hascombe and Dunsfold, Waverley D

DECISION

These disputes relate to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No. CL 130 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Surrey County Council and are occasioned by three Objections:No. 267 by F C Adams noted in the Register on 25 September 1970, No. 312 by F C and M Adams and No. 346 by Surrey County Council both noted in the Register on 8 October 1970.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the disputes at Guildford on 4 March 1931. The hearing was attended by Mr B E H Cotter, Solicitor, of Surrey County Council, Mr A R Hart, Solicitor of Waverley District Council, successor authority to Hambledon RDC, the applicant for the registration: and by Mr W F Norris, Solicitor, appearing on behalf of Mr F C Adams and Mrs M Adams.

The land comprised in the Register Unit comprises two separate moas. Objection Nos. 267 and 312 (Mr and Mrs Adams) relate to the northern area Loxhill ("the N area"). The County Council's Objection relates to strips on both areas claimed to be highway and coloured pink on a plan produced at the hearing. The Objections were accepted and accordingly I confirm the registration modified by excluding the N area and these strips.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
