



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No. 236/D/470

In the Matter of Queen's Park, Church Road, Caterham  
Tandridge D.

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No 1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No.VG.67 in the Register of Town or Village Greens maintained by the Surrey County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 85 made by Caterham and Warlingham Urban District Council and noted in the Register on 15 May 1970.

I held a hearing (adjourned from 26 June 1981) for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Dorking on 29 October 1981. The hearing was attended by Mr R C Wilson, Solicitor, appearing on behalf of Tandridge District Council, the successor to the Objector. The registration was made on the application of Mr J E Pearce, who had written to say that he now withdrew the registration, which accordingly I refuse to confirm.

I am required by regulation 30 (1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
