



In the Matter of Recreation Ground, Pot Common,  
Elstead, Surrey

## DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land section of Register Unit No. VG 74 in the Register of Town or Village Greens maintained by the Surrey County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 313 made by the Elstead Parish Council and noted in the Register on 27 October 1970.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Guildford on 21 May 1981. The hearing was attended by Mr P Clayden, the Secretary of the Commons, Open Spaces, and Footpaths Preservation Society, the applicant for the registration, by Mr B Cotter, solicitor, on behalf of the Surrey County Council, and by Miss A M Deacon, solicitor, on behalf of the Waverley District Council. There was no appearance on behalf of the Objector, but there was produced to me a letter dated 11 October 1973, addressed to the Clerk of the former Surrey County Council, in which the Objector's then Clerk stated that it had been decided to "withdraw" the Objection.

In these circumstances I confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
