



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

In the Matter of Roadside Waste in Grant's
Lane, Limpsfield, Tandridge D

DECISION

These disputes relate to the registrations at Entry No. 1 in the Land Section and Entries No. 1 and 2 in the Rights Section of Register Unit No. CL 437 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Surrey County Council and are occasioned by two Objections, No. 302 made by Mr K D Day and No. 565 made by Surrey County Council and noted in the Register respectively on 8 October 1970 and 26 May 1972.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Oxted on 24 June 1981. The hearing was attended by Mr B E H Cotter, Solicitor, of Surrey County Council. Both Entries in the Rights Section were made on the application of Miss V E G Macewen and the Entry in the Land Section was made in consequence of that application. The rights were claimed in respect of Doghurst Farm, and the present owner has written to say that he wished to withdraw the claim. Mr Day's objection has also been withdrawn, but Objection No. 565 is maintained by the County Council. In these circumstances I refuse to confirm the registrations.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
