



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No. 236/D/5 and 6

In the Matter of Salgasson Meadows  
(Lammas Land), Godalming, Waverley  
D., Surrey

DECISION

These disputes relate to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No. CL.380 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Surrey County Council and are occasioned by Objection Nos. 98 and 555 each made by the Thames Water Authority and noted in the Register on 7th July 1970 and 12th April 1972, respectively.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the disputes at Guildford on 26 March 1975. The hearing was attended by Mr. W.F. Norris of Messrs. Barlows solicitors for the West Surrey Society who registered the land as common land.

Mr. Norris told me that he had no evidence that the land was subject to common rights or waste land of a manor at the date of registration and did not support the registration as regards the land, the subject of the Thames Water Authority objections or as regards the land comprised in O.S. 243.

In the absence of any objection to the remainder of the land I am in the exercise of my discretion prepared to confirm the registration as regard that land.

For these reasons I confirm the registration with the following modifications:- namely, the exclusion of the land the subject of objections Nos. 98 and 555 and O.S. 243.

I am required by regulation 35(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
