



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No 236/D/130

In the Matter of Shabden Roadside,  
High Road, Chipstead, Reigate and  
Banstead Borough, Surrey

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No 1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No CL. 80 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Surrey County Council and is occasioned by Objection No 202 made by the said Council and noted in the Register on 10 September 1970.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Guildford on 19 October 1977. At the hearing Reigate and Banstead Borough Council were represented by Mr P D C Brown their solicitor and Surrey County Council were represented by Mr P W Pilgrim, articled clerk with the Deputy County Clerk.

Mr Brown and Mr Pilgrim said it was agreed that I should refuse to confirm the registration and handed me a statement to this effect signed by the Chief Executives of the Councils concerned.

It seems to me that I ought to act on this agreement, and accordingly I refuse to confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
