



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No. 236/D/187

In the Matter of Shalford Common (part),  
Shalford, Surrey

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No 1 in the Ownership Section of Register Unit No. CL.128 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Surrey County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 490 made by the former Guildford Rural District Council and noted in the Register on 15 February 1971.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Guildford on 26 April 1979. The hearing was attended by Mr R G Gould, a legal executive of the Guildford Borough Council. There was no appearance by or on behalf of Mr F D Fenston, the applicant for the registration, but Mr Gould informed me that he was instructed not to pursue the Objection.

In these circumstances I confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30 (1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
