



In the Matter of St John's Lye (part)  
Woking, Surrey (No. 1).

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land section of Register Unit No. CL 413 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Surrey County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 130 made by the former Woking Urban District Council and noted in the Register on 22 July 1970.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Guildford on 6 October 1977. The hearing was attended by Mr R T Salt, solicitor, on behalf of Mr and Mrs T A McLaurin, the applicants for the registration, and the Woking Borough Council was represented by Mr R A Payne, its Principal Legal Assistant.

Mr Salt and Mr Payne agreed that only the northern part of the land was properly included in the Register Unit.

In these circumstances I confirm the registration with the following modification :- namely the exclusion of the land coloured pink on an agreed plan submitted to me.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
