



In the Matter of The Broadmead, Send, Surrey, (No 2)

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registrations at Entry Nos 1 and 2 in the Rights Section of Register Unit No CL 54 in the Register of Common Land maintained by Objection No 308 made by Greysht Farms Ltd and noted in the Register on 8 October 1970.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Guildford on 27 April 1979. The hearing was attended by Mr D B Pugh, of Counsel, on behalf of Mr M W B May, the applicant for the registration at Entry No 1, and by Mr C Rymer, of Counsel, on behalf of the Objectors. There was no appearance by or on behalf of Mr J Oliver and Mr F Oliver, the applicants for the registration at Entry No 2, but their solicitors informed the Clerk of the Commons Commissioners by letter before the hearing that they wished to "withdraw" their application.

Mr Pugh and Mr Rymer informed me that it had been agreed that the land the subject of the Objection should be excluded from the Register Unit and that the registration at Entry No 1 should be confirmed.

In these circumstances I confirm the registration at Entry No. 1, and I refuse to confirm the registration at Entry No 2.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
