



In the Matter of The Cricket Ground
(Frensham Pond) Frensham

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registrations in the Land and Ownership Section of Register Unit No. VG.45 in the Register of Town or Village Greens maintained by the Surrey County Council and are occasioned by Objection No. 664 made by Surrey County Council and noted in the Register on 1 August 1972 and by the conflicting registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land section of Register Unit CL.227 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Council.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Guildford on 5 February 1981. At the hearing Frensham Parish Council (the applicant for registration in both the Land and the Ownership Section) was represented by the Chairman Mr C Stagg; Surrey County Council by Mr B E H Cotter, Solicitor; Waverley District Council by Mr R A Hunt, Solicitor and Mr B M Tussler, who applied for registration in the Rights Section of CL.227, by Mr R Godfrey of the firm of W H Hadfield and Son, Solicitors.

The parties agreed that the VG. registration should be cancelled and accordingly I refuse to confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30 (1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
