



In the Matter of Tiltham's Green, Shalford
Surrey (No. 1)

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land section of Register Unit No. CL 316 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Surrey County Council and is occasioned by Objection No: 670 made by the former Surrey County Council and noted in the Register on 1 August 1972.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Guildford on 15 June 1977. The hearing was attended by Miss H B Sutherland, solicitor, on behalf of the Guildford Borough Council, the successor authority of the former Guildford Rural District Council, the applicant for the registration, by Mr P W Pilgrim, solicitor, on behalf of the Surrey County Council, and by Mr J D Gould, Clerk of the Shalford Parish Council.

I was informed that the parties had agreed that there should be excluded from the registration two sight-line areas at the junction of Tiltham's Corner Road and the A3100 (Guildford to Godalming) Road, defined on an agreed plan, a tarmac footpath along the south side of Tiltham's Corner Road from the A3100 Road to the estate road known as Tiltham's Green, and a roadside verge 3 ft wide from Tiltham's Green to the end of the land comprised in the Register Unit at the River Wey Navigation.

In these circumstances I confirm the registration with the following modifications:- namely the exclusion of the two sight-line areas, the tarmac footpath, and the roadside verge.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
