

In the Matter of Wood Street Green, Worplesdon, Surrey (No.4).

DECISION

These disputes relate to the deemed registrations at Entry Nos 1 to 17 in the Rights section of Register Unit No. VG 39 in the Register of Town or Village Greens maintained by the Surrey County Council and are occasioned by the conflicting registrations at Entry No. 1 in the Land section of Register Unit No. CL 46 and at Entry No. 1 in the Land section of Register Unit No. CL 73 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Council.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Guildford on 4 May 1979. The hearing was attended by Mr P F Myers, Solicitor, on behalf of the Surrey County Council. The applicants for the deemed registrations have all agreed on the manner in which I am to deal with their corresponding registrations in Register Units CL 46 and CL 73.

In these circumstances I refuse to confirm this registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, with in 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
