



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No. 239/D/9

In the Matter of The Green at The Eastern End  
of the Village Stourton Warwickshire (No. 2)

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Rights Section of Register Unit No. VG.5 in the Register of Town or Village Greens, maintained by the Warwickshire County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 31 made by the Stourton Parish Council and noted in the Register on 21 October 1970.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Stratford Upon Avon on 1 November 1978. The hearing was attended by Mr D C Wynn, Solicitor, on behalf of Mr L P Gasson, Mr E Gasson and Mr R W Gasson; the applicants for the registration.

I heard this case at the same time as In the Matter of The Green at The Eastern End of the Village Stourton (NO. 1) (1978) 239/U/14, in which Mr Wynn's clients claimed to be the owners of the land comprised in the Register Unit. For the reasons given in my decision in that case I have come to the conclusion that that claim has been substantiated. It therefore follows, as Mr Wynn submitted, that his clients cannot be entitled to the rights of common the subject of this registration

For these reasons I refuse to confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30 (1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
