



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No. 239/D/4-5

In the Matter of The River Bank and Osier Beds
to the South of All Saints Church, Luddington,
Warwickshire

DECISION

Those disputes relate to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land section of Register Unit No. CL 50 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Warwickshire County Council and are occasioned by Objection No. 52 made by Mr K Homer-Lee and noted in the Register on 20 October 1971 and Objection No. 53 made by the Upper Avon Navigation Trust Ltd and noted in the Register on 11 January 1972.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Stratford-upon-Avon on 1 November 1978. The hearing was not attended by any person entitled to be heard, but the Solicitors for the Luddington Parish Council, the applicant for the registration, informed the Clerk of the Commons Commissioners by letter before the hearing that their client wished to "withdraw" the application.

In these circumstances I refuse to confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
