In the Matter of Manorial Waste (1) near Bannerds Copse, Oldhams Copse and Buckfold Farm, (2) triangular piece, between Great Hesters Copse and Brinksole Waste, (3) near Sand Copse and Burrell's Cottage on Balls Cross Road and (4) the northern end of Byworth Hanger and near High Hoes Copse, all in Petworth, Chichester District, West Sussex

DECISION

These disputes relate to the registrations at Entry No 1 in the Land Section of Register Unit (1) No CL. 286, (2) CL. 287, (3) No CL. 302 and (4) No CL. 282 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the West Sussex County Council and are occasioned by Objections (1) No 591, (2) No 553, (3) No 550 and (4) No 566 respectively, made by the County Surveyor and noted in the Register on (1) 20 July (2) 19 June, (3) 12 June and (4) 29 June 1972 respectively.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the disputes at Chichester on 22 March 1977. At the hearing Rt Hon Pamela Baroness Egremont, Sir Philip Francis de Zulueta and Mr Joseph Frederick Burrell (trustees of the Leconfield Estates) on whose application the registrations were made were represented by Mr W M Hamer surveyor with Smiths Gore, Chartered Surveyors of Petworth and West Sussex County Council were represented by Mr A Edwards articled clerk to the County Secretary.

Mr Hamer and Mr Edwards handed me the terms of the decision to be given by me signed by or on behalf of all the persons entitled to be heard at the hearing of these disputes, which terms are that the Commons Commissioner do confirm the said registrations.

I am willing to give a decision in accordance with the proposed terms and I accordingly confirm the registration without any modification.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
