



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference Nos. 238/D/109-110

In the Matter of Brinkshole Hanger, Petworth and
Fittleworth, West Sussex

DECISION

These disputes relate to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No. CL.209 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the West Sussex County Council and are occasioned by Objection No. 114 made by the Trustees of the Leconfield Estate and noted in the Register on 18 May 1970 and Objection No. 455 made by the former County Surveyor, and noted in the Register on 30 March 1971.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Chichester on 12 May 1980. The hearing was attended by Mr A R Dickinson, the Objectors' land agent, and Mrs G Frankland, the County Council's Commons Registration Officer.

The land was registered by the former Registration Authority without application. Mrs Frankland informed me that she was instructed not to support the application.

In these circumstances I refuse to confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
