



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

In the Matter of Heyshott Green, Heyshott,  
West Sussex (No. 2)

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No. VG 17 in the Register of Town or Village Greens maintained by the West Sussex County Council and is occasioned by the conflicting registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No. CL 218 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Council.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Chichester on 14 May 1980. The hearing was attended by Mrs G Frankland, the Commons Registration Officer of the County Council, the successor authority of the former West Sussex County Council, which made the conflicting registration as Registration Authority without application. There was no appearance on behalf of the Heyshott Parish Council, the applicant for the registration.

Mrs Frankland informed me that she was instructed not to support the conflicting registration.

In these circumstances I confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
