DECISION

These disputes relate to the registrations at Entry No 1 in the Land Section and at Entry Nos 1, 2 and 3 in the Rights Section of Register Unit No CL. 22 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the West Sussex County Council and is occasioned by Objection No 332 made by the County Surveyor and noted in the Register on 30 September 1970.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the disputes at Chichester on 13 April 1978. At the hearing Chichester County Council were represented by Mr R Lester, local government officer in the County Secretary's Department.

The grounds of the Objection are: "Part area is highway, see attached" and the attached paper stated that the area adjoining the paved highway is highway for the widths therein set out from the centre of the carriage way.

Mr Lester said that the County Surveyor withdraws the Objection, relying on section 21(2) of the 1965 Act.

Under the Act the registrations would have become final but for the Objection. I consider I should upon the withdrawal of the Objection produce the same result; accordingly I confirm the registrations without any modification.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
