



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

In the Matter of Lodsworth Common,

DECISION

These disputes relate to the registration at No 1 in the Land Section and the registration at Entry Nos 1, 2 and 4 in the Rights Section of Register Unit No CL. 24 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the West Sussex County Council and are occasioned by Objection No 355 made by the County Surveyor and noted in the Register on 1 January 1971 and Objections Nos 37 and 76 both made by The Cowdrey Trust Ltd and Dickinson Trust Ltd and respectively noted in the Register on 10 March and 23 June 1969.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Midhurst on 5 October 1976. The hearing was attended by Mr R A Lester on behalf of the West Sussex County Council, Mr R D Stafford on behalf of the Cowdrey Trust Ltd and Dickinson Trust Ltd, Mr D H Stott of Messrs Alberry & Lucas on behalf of Mr E C Boxall an applicant for Rights and Mr C H Barnes on behalf of Lodsworth Parish Council. Mr Lester and Mr Stafford withdrew the respective Objections made by the parties respectively represented by them and I therefore confirm the registrations modified in the case of that made by Mr Boxall in the Rights Section so as to exclude the following words: (b) 50 chickens. Chickens are not commonable animals.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
