



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference Nos. 238/D/185-186

In the Matter of Lurgashall Green,
Lurgashall, West Sussex (No. 1)

DECISION

These disputes relate to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No. CL 303 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the West Sussex County Council and are occasioned by Objection No. 601 made by the former County Surveyor and noted in the Register on 4 August 1972 and the conflicting registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No. VG 43 in the Register of Town or Village Greens maintained by the Council.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Chichester on 14 May 1980. The hearing was attended by Mr A R Dickinson, the land agent of the Trustees of the Leconfield Estate, the applicants for the registration, Mrs M E Boxall, the Clerk of the Lurgashall Parish Council, and Mrs G Frankland, the Commons Registration Officer of the County Council. There was no appearance on behalf of the Haslemere Preservation Society, the applicant for the conflicting registration.

Mrs Frankland informed me that the County Council did not wish to support the Objection, and Mr Dickinson asked for the registration to be confirmed with the exclusion of the land the subject of the conflicting registration.

In these circumstances I confirm the registration with the following modification; namely, the exclusion of the land comprised in the conflicting registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
