



In the Matter of Manorial Waste on the Public
Highway North-West of the Village of Kirdford (No. 2)

DECISION

These disputes relate to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Rights section of Register Unit No. CL 109 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the West Sussex County Council and are occasioned by Objection No. 213 made by the National Trust and noted in the Register on 21 October 1970 and Objection No 320 made by the County Surveyor of the former West Sussex County Council.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Chichester on 17 February 1981. The hearing was attended by Mrs G Frankland, the Commons Registration Officer of the West Sussex County Council.

Mrs Frankland informed me that she was instructed not to pursue Objection No. 320.

Mrs P J Calthrop, the applicant for the registration has sold her property to Mr L Knight. Mr Knight stated in a letter dated 5 February 1981 that he did not propose to oppose the Objections.

In these circumstances I refuse to confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
