

COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference Nos.38/D/51-53

In the Matter of The Beaches, Land and Saltings, West Beach, Selsey, West Sussex.

DECISION

These disputes relate to the registration at Entry No.1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No.C.L.11 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the West Sussex County Council and are occasioned by Objection No.20 made by Mr. G.E. Bunn and Objection No.21 made by White Horse Caravan Co.Ltd. and both noted in the Register on 16th January 1969 and by Objection No.89 made by Gannetus Ltd and noted in the Register on 24th September 1969.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Chichester on 5th July 1973. The hearing was attended by Mr. Ritchie, of counsel, for the Selsey Parish Council, the applicant for the registration, and by Miss Cameron, of counsel, on behalf of the Objectors.

This case is indistinguishable from <u>In the Matter of the Beaches</u>, <u>Selsey</u> (1973), Nos.38/D/39-42, and I therefore refuse to confirm the registration and I make no order as to costs.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
