



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No.38/D/33

In the Matter of The Severalls and  
East Beach (part), Selsey, West Sussex.

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No.1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No.C.L.3 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the West Sussex County Council and is occasioned by Objection No.1 made by Severalls Estates Ltd and noted in the Register on 10th October 1968.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Chichester on 4th July 1973. The hearing was attended by Mr. Ritchie, of counsel, on behalf of the Selsey Parish Council, the applicant for the registration, and by Mr. L.V. Smith, a director of the Objector.

Mr. Ritchie said that the basis of the application was that the land the subject of the dispute was waste land of the manor, but that having considered the Inclosure Act and Award referred to in my decision in In the Matter of the Fishing Beach, Selsey (1973), Nos.38/D/5-7, he was not able to support the registration.

For these reasons I refuse to confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
