

COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965



Reference No. 270/D/101-102

In the Matter of the Waste situated south of
Oxenhope Stoop Hill, between Deep Mitch and
the Bradford Borough Boundary

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registrations at Entry No. 1 in the Land and Rights Section of Register Unit No. CL 582 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the former West Riding County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 1545 made by the Rt. Hon. George Halifax, Baron Savile and noted in the Register on 21 March 1972.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Bradford on 21 October 1981. The hearing was attended by Mr C M Pepper, Senior Assistant, Solicitor for the applicants Bradford Metropolitan City Council and Mr R S Preston-Jones, Agent for the Objector Baron Savile.

I was informed that the Objection had been withdrawn and both parties invited me to confirm the registrations in the Land and Rights Sections.

For these reasons I confirm both registrations.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
