



In the Matter of Tollard Green, Tollard Royal,  
Wiltshire

DECISION

This reference relates to the question of the ownership of land known as Tollard Green, Tollard Royal, being the land comprised in the Land Section of Register Unit No. CL 81 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Wiltshire County Council of which no person is registered under section 4 of the Commons Registration Act 1965 as the owner.

Following upon the public notice of this reference Mr M A L F Pitt-Rivers claimed to be the freehold owner of the land in question and no other person claimed to have information as to its ownership.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the question of the ownership of the land at Salisbury on 23 November 1981.

At the hearing Mr Pitt-Rivers was represented by Mr D M Morris, Solicitor.

The land in question was conveyed to Mr Pitt-Rivers by a Conveyance made 1 January 1950 between (1) George Henry Lane Fox Pitt-Rivers (2) Michael Augustus Lane Fox Pitt-Rivers and has since been in the possession of Mr Pitt-Rivers.

On this evidence I am satisfied that Mr Pitt-Rivers is the owner of the land, and I shall accordingly direct the Wiltshire County Council, as registration authority, to register him as the owner of the land under section 8(2) of the Act of 1965.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
