



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

(2) Hillesley Memorial Green, both in Hawkesbury,
North Avon District, Avon

DECISION

These references relate to the question of the ownership of lands (1) known as Hawkesbury Memorial Green containing about .07 of an acre, and (2) known as Hillesley Memorial Green containing .023 of an acre, both in Hawkesbury, North Avon District being the land comprised in the Land Section of Register Unit (1) No. VG. 176, and (2) No. VG. 177 respectively in the Register of Town or Village Greens maintained by the Avon County Council (formerly Gloucestershire County Council) of which no person is registered under section 4 of the Commons Registration Act 1965 as the owner.

Following upon the public notice of this reference no person claimed to be the freehold owner of the lands in question and no other person claimed to have information as to their ownership.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the question of the ownership of the lands at Bristol on 9 March 1976. There was no attendance at the hearing.

In the absence of any evidence I am not satisfied that any person is the owner of the land, and I shall accordingly direct the Avon County Council, as registration authority, to register Hawkesbury Upton Parish Council as the owner of the land under section 8(3) of the Act of 1965.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
