DECISION

These disputes relate to the registrations at Entry Nos. 2 to 8 (inclusive) in the Rights Section of Register Unit No.G/CL127 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Avon County Council and ~~are~~ occasioned by Objection No. 101 made by the former Gloucestershire County Council and noted in the Register on 11 March 1971.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Bath on 19 July 1983. The hearing was attended by Miss D Jenkins Evans, Solicitor, on behalf of the Avon County Council, the successor authority of the Objector. There was no appearance by or on behalf of any of the applicants for the registrations.

The objection relates to only two small areas of land which have been excluded from the Register Unit by any decision in In the Matter of Lyde Green Common, Pucklechurch (No.1), (1983) Ref. No. 260/D/181.

In these circumstances I confirm the registrations.

I am required by regulation 30 (1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.


