In the Matter of Siston Common, Goose Green and Webb's Heath, Siston. Avon (NO.1)

DECISION

These disputes relate to the registration at Entry No 1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No.CL.29 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Avon County Council and are occasioned by Objection No. 26 made by Mrs D Gent and noted in the Register on 14 May 1970, Objection No. 73 made by Mr R J Turner Objection No. 76 made by Mr R W Pyle, Objection No. 78 made by Mr J Evans and Objection No. 118 made by Messrs. S R and E London and all noted in the Register on 15 December 1970. And Objection No. 96 made by the former Gloucestershire County Council and noted in the Register on 17 March 1971, and Objection No. 155 made by Mr L A Barker. and noted in the Register on 31 March 1971

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Bath on 3 June 1980. The hearing was attended by Mr A Hudson of the Legal Department of the Avon County Council. the successor authority of the former Somersed County Council. by whom the registration was made in consequence of the application for the registration at Entry Mo. 1 in the Rights Section of the Register Unit by Mr S C Fussell, by Mr J A Whitehead, Solicitor, on behalf of Mr Fussell and by Mr D J Bellew. Solicitor on behalf of Mr and Mrs Reed. the successors in title of Mrs Gent, and Mr Pyle appeared in person.

All the objectors related to the inclusion in the Register Unit of comparatively small areas of land. I was informed that all these areas could be excluded from the Register Unit.

I confirm the registration with the following modifications, namely, the exclusion of the land the subject of each of the objections.

I am required by regulation 30 (1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to emplain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
