



In the Matter of The Parish Pump, Kewstoke, Avon.

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land section of Register Unit No. CL 218 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the former Somerset County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. O/303 made by the former County Council and noted in the Register on 23 August 1972.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Weston-super-Mare on 19 October 1972. The hearing was attended by Mr E Moore, the Clerk of the Kewstoke Parish Council, the applicant for the registration, and Mr A James, solicitor on behalf of the Avon County Council, the successor authority of the Objector.

Mr Moore stated that he could not support the registration.

In these circumstances I refuse to confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
