



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No. 1/D/12

In the Matter of Old Clay Pit,
Aspley Guise, Bedfordshire (No.3).

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No.2 in the Rights Section of Register Unit No.C.L.27 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the former Bedfordshire County Council and is occasioned by Objection No.22 made by Greenway Developments (Harpenden) Ltd and noted in the Register on 21st August 1970.

All the persons entitled to be heard at the hearing of this dispute have agreed upon the terms of the decision to be given by me and have sent to the Clerk of the Commons Commissioners particulars of such terms signed by or on behalf of all such persons.

I am satisfied that there is no person who, if a hearing were held, would be entitled to be heard upon giving his name and address to me and satisfying me that he had succeeded to the interest, or part of the interest of any other person.

I am willing to give a decision in accordance with the proposed terms and I accordingly confirm the registration. In the interests of clarity, I should explain that the area of the Register Unit has been reduced by the decision which I gave by consent in Reference No.1/D/10.
