



In the Matter of Brimpton Common, Brimpton,
Berkshire (No. 2)

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No 1 in the Rights section of Register Unit No CL 95 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Berkshire County Council and is occasioned by Objection No 187 made by the Brimpton Parish Council and noted in the Register on 28 July 1972.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Newbury on 31 January 1978. The hearing was attended by Mr P E Taylor, the applicant for the registration, and Mr E Farrance, the Clerk of the Brimpton Parish Council.

It was necessary for me to consider this registration for the purpose of my decision in In the Matter of Brimpton Common (No 1) (1978), Ref. No 202/D/8, and for the reasons stated in that decision I refuse to confirm this registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
