



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

In the Matter of Cricket Green Cookham Dean,
Cookham, Berkshire

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No 1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No.VG.78 in the Register of Town or Village Greens maintained by the Berkshire County Council and is occasioned by the conflicting registration at Entry No 1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No.CL.63 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Council.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Windsor on 14 December 1978. The hearing was attended by Mrs J M Hill, the Clerk of the Cookham Parish Council, the applicants for the registration and Mr P R Fitzgerald, Solicitor, on behalf of the National Trust, the applicant for the conflicting registration.

Mr Fitzgerald informed me that he was instructed not to support the conflicting registration in so far as it was in conflict with the registration.

In these circumstances I confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 50 (1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
