



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No. 202/D/116

In the Matter of Land at Cookham Dean,
Lugwood Common and Cookham Moor, Cookham,
Berkshire (No. 1)

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No 1 in the Land Section of Register No. CL.63 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Berkshire County Council. It is occasioned by the conflicting registration at Entry No 1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No. VG.78 in the Register of Town or Village Greens maintained by the Council.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Windsor on 14 December 1973. The hearing was attended by Mr P R Fitzgerald, Solicitor, on behalf of the National Trust, the applicant for the registration, and Mrs J M Hill, the Clerk of the Cookham Parish Council, the applicant for the conflicting registration.

Mr Fitzgerald informed me that he was instructed not to support the registration in so far as it was in conflict with the conflicting registration.

In these circumstances I confirm the registration with the following modification: namely the exclusion of the land comprised in the conflicting registration.

As required by regulation 30 (1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 I declare that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law, may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
