DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No. VG 95 in the Register of Town or Village Greens maintained by the Berkshire County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 156 made by Mr J N Sheffield and noted in the Register on 16 February 1971.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Windsor on 13 December 1978. The hearing was attended by Commander D B Cairns, the Honorary Secretary of the Twyford and Ruscombe Residents Association, the applicant for the registration, and by Mr A J Southorn, Solicitor, on behalf of Mr Alan Godsal, on whose behalf Mr Sheffield made the Objection.

Mr Southorn informed me that he was instructed not to oppose the registration and that he would in due course apply to be registered as the owner of the land.

In these circumstances I confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
