DECISION

These references relate to the question of the ownership of (1) land containing about 0.20 of an acre and (2) land containing about 1.05 acres being village greens in Thornborough, Aylesbury Vale District and being the lands comprised in the 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> Sections of Register Unit (1) No CL. 245 and (2) No CL. 246 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Buckinghamshire County Council of which no person is registered under section 4 of the Commons Registration Act 1965 as the owner.

Following upon the public notice of this reference Thornborough Parish Council through their solicitors wanted their interest recorded mainly in the establishment of the right to the management of the village greens including the creation of byelaws as relevant. No other person claimed to be the freehold owner of the lands in question or to have information as to their ownership.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the question of the ownership of the lands at Aylesbury on 4 October 1977. There was no appearance at the hearing.

In the absence of any evidence I am not satisfied that any person is the owner of the lands and they will therefore remain subject to protection under section 9 of the Act of 1965.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
